Entries: Entries will be allowed on the day of the trial until 7:00 A.M. *Please notify the Trial Secretary in advance if you are considering day of show entry to speed the registration process.* Entries without fees will not be accepted. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement on the back or attached will not be accepted. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries will not be accepted and cannot be entered in the Trial. Credit card payments cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

Day of event entries must be given to the secretary no later than 7:30 A.M.

Awards: Ribbons for 1st – 3rd place.

Measuring, Familiarization and Check In: 8:00 A.M. to 8:30 A.M., Judge's Briefing to follow.

Judging: will begin at 9:00 A.M.

- Exercise your dog responsibly! Please pick up after your dog at the show site and hotels
- All dogs must be on leash except when in the ring or warm up area

Eligibility

This trial is open to all dogs measuring 20 inches or less at the withers, over the age of 12 months. The trial is not open to aggressive dogs, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance, or bitches in season. In the latter case and with a note from a veterinarian, a refund of all but \$# of entry fees will be provided.

Your dog must be registered with TDAA to participate in TDAA Trials. Here is a link to the TDAA Dog Registration form: [TDAA Dog Registration Form](#). Please provide proof of submission to the trial secretary if you haven't received your number

TDAA Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at the [TDAA web site](#), and should be reviewed before competing at a TDAA trial.

Height Divisions: Per TDAA rules, dogs may be entered at any jump height desired (except at the Petit Prix: please see that premium for details); however, the scoring height continues to be the dog's measured jump height. Dogs jumping at a height other than their measured height will earn qualifying legs and all TDAA titles. The judge reserves the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. Any dog that has not previously competed at a TDAA trial must be measured before competing.

Veteran Dogs: A veteran dog is a dog of at least 7 years of age. Veteran dogs receive additional course time in standard runs and games that are timed. 4" (Measured Jump Height) veterans receive an additional 4 seconds, while 8", 12", and 16" veterans receive an additional 2 seconds.

Double Digit Veteran Dogs: A double-digit veteran dog is a dog of at least 10 years of age. Double-digit veteran dogs receive 2 seconds in addition to what a veteran dog receives for standard course time and for games that are timed.

Disabled Handler Exemption: Handlers who have been given disability status by their home state will be allowed an additional 4 seconds in standard course time for Standard courses and an additional 4 seconds in qualifying course time for Games classes. This is in addition to any additional time awarded through the Veteran Dog exemption. A copy of the handler's disabled parking permit must be sent with the entry or presented 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

Standard Class

Beginner Agility—All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Intermediate Agility — Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) title shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Superior Agility — Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) title shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Class

Games I—All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games II — Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) title shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games III — Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) title shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Trial Games

HOT LAPS	Hot Laps is the perfect warm up game. This is a game variation not in the Book of Agility Games. The course consists of numbered tunnels and jumps. One circle is completed then a jump wrap and a 2nd circle is run. ER5
TURKEY CHUTE	This a dogs choice game. The objective is to score as many points as possible, choosing a doubling or tripling obstacle on course, as often as possible. Scored points, then time ER2
POWER & SPEED	This is a two part game. In the first part [Power] the dog will run an un-timed sequence of mostly technical obstacles; and in the second part [Speed] the dog will run a timed jumpers course. ER5
BLACK HOLE	Black Hole is a numbered course requiring the handler to simply avoid any tunnels with his dog. A dog that goes into a Black Hole is subject to a significant penalty. Black Hole is scored Time, Plus Faults. ER5
BLACK JACK	Blackjack is a dog's-choice game in which the dog must accumulate 21 points in the fastest time; going over 21 points disqualifies the team. During point accumulation the dog must score at least one obstacle from three obstacle types. Blackjack is scored Points, Then Time. ER10

Judges reserve the right to adapt any game played. Day of show rules supersede all others.

The judge's briefing, given prior to the start of judging, supersedes these descriptions and the written briefings of how to play any game. **More information about games** is available in the Book of Agility Games, 5th Edition, available at <https://k9tdaa.com>.

Warm-Ups: A warm-up area consisting of at least an agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

Obstacle Familiarization: Obstacle familiarization on TDAA equipment will be offered 30 minutes before the first class each day. One dog in the ring at a time.

Move-Ups: If your dog has moved up since you sent in your application, please notify the trial secretary at least 48 hours prior to the trial. Include the following information:

Move-ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this trial. In such case, the move-up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned. Move-ups will be accepted each day from event to event.

The following is a list of obstacles that may be used:

Pipe Tunnels (24" opening)	Teeter 12' planks, 12" wide without slats
Weaves (24" centers)	Dog Walk 12' planks, 12" wide with slats
Tire (24" opening)	Table 36" square
Jumps (40" wide) with or without wings	A-Frame 5' apex, ramp 9' x 36", with slats

FEO (For Exhibition Only)

FEO (For Exhibition Only): TDAA offers FEO runs. They are open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. These are offered at the option of the local/host club. FEO dogs will run last in their jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. FEO teams will have a maximum time of 1.5 times the SCT. FEO dogs cannot repeat any obstacles, no training in the ring.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.
- All fees must be paid in US funds. There will be a Returned Check Fee of \$15 for returned checks. In the event of withdrawal from the event, checks will NOT be returned. All unused checks will be destroyed.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Aggressive behavior by any dog will not be tolerated. Any aggressive behavior will result in the Trial Committee evaluating the situation and determining whether any action is necessary, up to the removal of a competitor from the tournament.
- All participants in TDAA events, including competitors, judges, regional master judges, trial chairs, secretaries, members, vendors, handlers, owners of dogs, and anyone else involved with a TDAA event must refrain from behavior detrimental to the confidence, or the public perception, of the TDAA's events and integrity.
- Those involved in the TDAA's events must behave in ways that do not negatively reflect on dog agility and the TDAA.
- Conduct by anyone that is reckless, careless, perilous, turbulent, violent, or illegal puts others at risk, damages the reputation of others in the TDAA organization, and undercuts public respect and support for the TDAA is to be avoided.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling, verbal abuse of trial personnel, or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring, and possibly expulsion from the tournament.
- All dogs must be always on leash except when using the warmup area or in the agility ring per state leash laws.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the TDAA Rules and Regulations.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.

Accommodations/Hotels

Please contact the hotel to verify that they still accept dogs, ask about size and number of dogs allowed, and fees. Make your reservation early.

Notice: All hotels/motels are considered part of our trial site and are subject to TDAA Rules and Regulations. Our Trial Committee will consider disciplinary action for any complaints lodged against an Exhibitor. Do not allow your dog(s) to destroy property or disturb other guests. *Please*, pick up after your dog both at the hotel and the trial site.

We are located within 20 minutes of the Temecula Wine Country. There are several hotels in the area such as South Coast Winery Resort and Spa. Temecula has several hotels that allow pets at a wide range of prices La Quinta Inn & Suites, Motel 6 are the most reasonable and are pet friendly.

We have a few dry camping spots available on site at \$15 per night. There are limited 20A electric & water hookups available at \$25/night. Please call Kathy Greenway at 574-344-1889 to make RV spot arrangements. Vail Ranch KOA on CA-79 is a full hook-up campground.

Directions if you are coming from North or South
Use I15 (from South or North) exit on Clinton Keith and go west 3.9 miles to the 3-way STOP sign at the top of the hill. Turn right on Avenue La Cresta and travel 3.9 miles to Calle de Companero. Turn right about .2 miles and take the first left on Vista de Montana. From there it is 1 mile to the T intersection at the bottom of the canyon. Turn right on Via Sereno and the ranch entrance is .2 miles on your right just after the creek crossing.

Parking and set up on site in large groomed dirt space. Bring shade for your dog, crating and working from your car. Limited space available in or near ringside.
