Directions to Site: From 15 South or North exit on Clinton Keith and go west 3.9 miles to the 3-way STOP sign at the top of the hill. Turn right on Avenue La Cresta and travel 3.9 miles to Calle de Companero. Turn right about .2 miles and take the first left on Vista de Montana. From there it is 1 mile to the T intersection at the bottom of the canyon. Turn right on Via Sereno and the ranch entrance is .2 miles on your right just after the creek crossing.

Show Site and Food

There will be water and a variety of drinks on hand. There will be some snacks. Participants are asked to bring their own lunch.

Accommodations

Please contact the hotel to verify acceptance of dogs, sizes and number of dogs limits or any pet deposits or fee that may be required: BE SURE to check if your motel still accepts dogs and make your reservation early.

NOTICE: All hotels/motels are considered part of our trial site and are subject to TDAA Rules and Regulations. Our Trial Committee consider disciplinary action for any complaints lodged against an Exhibitor. Do not allow your dog(s) to destroy property or disturb other guests. *Please*, pick up after your dog both at the hotel and the trial site.

Hotel and RV camping

We are located within 20 minutes of the Temecula Wine Country. There are several hotels in the area such as South Coast Winery Resort and Spa. Temecula has several hotels that allow pets at a wide range of prices La Quinta Inn & Suites, Motel 6 are the most reasonable and are pet friendly.

We have a few dry camping spots available on site at \$15 per night. There are limited 20A electric & water hookups available at \$25/night. Please call Kathy Greenway at 574-344-1889 to make RV spot arrangements. Vail Ranch KOA on CA-79 is a full hook-up campground.

ENTRIES & CLOSING DATE: Your entry must be **RECEIVED by October 18, 2024 to obtain the discount price.** Day of trial entries will be accepted at the regular price per run. To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date, and accompanied by the correct fees made payable to **Kathy Greenway**. You must file a separate entry form for each dog entered (i.e., only one dog per form).

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. A refund of all but \$5.00 will be given for bitches in season. A letter from your veterinarian is required by the first day of the Trial.
- All fees must be paid in US funds. There will be a Returned Check Fee of \$25.00 for returned checks.
- In the event of withdrawal from the event, checks will NOT be returned. All unused checks will be destroyed.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when using the warm-up area or in the agility ring.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the Trial.
- Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs at the hotel and at the Trial Site.
- Treats are allowed as a reward, but cannot be used to lure the dog in the arena. Non audible toy can be carried during the run, but cannot be visible. Use of the toy can only be utilized after the last obstacle has been completed.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignias of their training group, if they wish.
- Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are PROHIBITED.

Obstacle Familiarization – Obstacle familiarization will be held after the briefing prior to judging.

Warm-Ups – A warm-up area consisting of a regulation agility jump shall be provided for all Exhibitors to share.

Show Site – The arena is fenced and has groomed level ground. All contacts have a rubberized surface. There is parking and set up around the arena with short walking distance to the gates. There is a restroom with running water and a flush toilet.

Eligibility - this trial is open to all dogs **22-inches** and under at the withers that are over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Move-Ups - Move-ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a prior show up to the closing date. Move-up requests must be in writing but may be sent via e-mail. Move-ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this Trial. In such case, the Move-Up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned. "Move-up Request Form" is set out later in premium and available on the Secretary's Table at show.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying Score. FEO (For Exhibition Only) will be offered.

Judging Times: Judging starts at **9:00 a.m.** • Site will open at 7:30 a.m. • Measuring: 8:00 a.m. • Briefings: 8:30 a.m. R.V. parking by appointment booked with Kathy Greenway at 574-344-1889.

The following is a list of standard equipment that will be used at the trial:

A-Frame: 5' apex, ramp 9' x 36", contact zone 36"

Table: 36" square with rubberized surface

Open Tunnel: 24" diameter, 15' long or less

Teeter: 12' x 12" x 48" tall

Attachable wing pairs: 30" H x 16" W

Weave Poles: 24" spacing, 30" tall

Tire Jump: 24" inside diameter

Dog Walk: 12' planks x12" wide, 4' tall with 36" contact

Jumps without wings: ¾" PVC, 36" tall x 40" wide

CLASS INFORMATION

Standard Class

Beginner Agility – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Intermediate Agility – Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Superior Agility – Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class. Dogs who have earned the Teacup Superior Agile Dog (TSAD) are also eligible for this class.

Games Classes

Games I - All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games II - Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games III - Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

1st Game: HALLOWEEN RACE

Halloween Race is a numbered course where the dog's faults will be added to his time. Halloween Race is scored Time, Plus Faults. ER5

2nd Game: HOWL-O-WEEN CHALLENGE

Howl-O-Ween Challenge is a numbered course with bonus points earned for collecting "treats" and performing distance challenge "tricks". Halloween Challenge is scored Time minus Bonus plus Faults. ER7

3rd Game: PUPPY CANNON

Puppy Cannon features the tunnel as a test of the handler's skill when redirecting the dog. It is played with three small numbered sequences that can be taken in the order of the handler's choosing. Puppy Cannon is scored Time, Plus Faults. ER5

4th Game: SEND ME

Send Me is a numbered course with bonus points earned for performing distance challenges. Scoring is Time minus Bonus plus Faults. ER7.

5th Game: TRICK OR TREAT

Trick or Treat is a standard course that includes a trick. An obstacle will be withdrawn from the numbered course after the walk-through and must be omitted by the dog and handler when the course is run. Trick or Treat is scored Time, Plus Faults. ER5

6th Game: MONSTER MASH

Monster Mash is a numbered course with a dance floor for dancing the Monster Mash. Monster Mash is scored Faults then Time. ER12

The judge will give a detailed briefing of each game's rules prior to running the course. For more information on these games the *Book of Agility Games* is available via the TDAA web site. Our Judges reserve the right to adapt any game played. Day of show rules supersede all others.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in any height division. Dogs that run in a height division other than their proper division will continue to be scored with dogs of their measured height, and will earn all qualifying runs and titles. TDAA height divisions are:

- 2" jump height: for dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers with body type or veterans' exemptions;
- 4" jump height: for dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers;
- 8" jump height: for dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers;
- 12" jump height: for dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers;
- 16" jump height: for dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers.

ALL DOGS WITHOUT A PERMANENT HEIGHT CARD must be measured prior to the first day of competing at this trial. Please arrive early enough to accommodate measuring.

TWO MEASUREMENTS BY 2 different TDAA JUDGES are needed to show a dog in the TDAA without requiring measurement.

For Exhibition Only (FEO)

TDAA allows FEO runs open to any TDAA registered dog in any class; offered at the option of the host club. FEO dogs may run on lead being held by exhibitor. Dropping the leash is deemed unsafe except running through a tunnel. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. Treats are allowed in the ring providing that they are not dropped. FEO will have a maximum of 1.5 times of the SCT (generally about 90 seconds). More FEO details will be explained at the trial.

Disabled Handlers

A time exemption will be granted to disabled handlers amounting to 4 seconds in Standard course times and in qualifying course times for Games classes. Proof of disability shall be a copy of the handler's disability parking tag or other official documentation, which must be included with the entry or presented at check-in at the trial.

Entries

Pre-registrations must be received by **October 18, 2024**, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted. Day of Event Entries **WILL BE** accepted **up and until 7:30 a.m.** each morning, for \$15.00 per run. TDAA Dog Registration Numbers may be applied for at the event so that your dog can participate in this trial.

Entries will not be accepted without fees. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry forms. One dog per entry form.

NOTE: The entry form has form fields on it so you can save to your computer and type on it, then print to mail to the Trial Secretary.

Photocopied entries, without the signed TDAA Agreement attached are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the Trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned check(s). Subsequent returned check(s) from the same Exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Agreement

(Include with your entry form)

I/We acknowledge that the "Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules & Regulations" have been made available to me/us, and that I am/We are familiar with their contents. I/We agree to hold the TDAA, TDAA approved judge and 2K Agility and Kathy Greenway harmless from any legal claim resulting from said Judge's action under the TDAA Rules, Regulations and Guidelines. I/We agree that 2K Agility has the right to refuse entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Agility Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged, I/We agree to hold harmless the directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or things by the act of this dog while in or upon the show/trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I/We personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I/We further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I/We hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time arising out of or in consequence of my/our participation in this Agility Trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

Instructions

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of the new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been made to TDAA.
